Although Wakefield City Centre remains a safe place, there have been some concerning incidents where young people have been the victims of crime. The problem areas appear to be TRINITY WALK and the bus station.

I would advise the following:

Let your parents/carers know where you are going and who you are with

Walk with another person or walk near other people

Stay in well lit areas and avoid shortcuts

Plan your routes and walk with purpose

Stay alert and keep headphones off

If you think you are being followed cross the road or go to a public place such as shops or cafes

Report your suspicions to police or security staff

Consider what items you take with you. If you must take valuable items with you consider marking your property
