


Attendance

High-level consequences figures are provided.




Honours

Awarded badges and outstanding badge requests are shown. You can browse/search all available badges and learn more about how to achieve them.


Students accessing the portal using their academy Google account can also request badges (parents/carers receive a read-only view of Honours).

Praise comments


All of the student's Praise comments are provided.




Praising Stars

Each report includes the same information as a printed report, adapted for display on a screen.






Timetable

You can scroll through two weeks of timetable.





Google Classroom Guardian Guide

What is Google Classroom Guardian Support?

Google Classroom guardian summaries allow parents and carers to opt-in to receive regular email updates about their child's work and classes. These emails, known as guardian email summaries, include information about missing work, upcoming work, and class activity including announcements and questions posted in the class stream. They are automatically generated and do not require any extra work on the behalf of the teacher.

What will guardians receive?

Guardians can choose the frequency of the emails; either daily (Monday to Friday) or weekly.

They do not get access to Google Classrooms and do not see the work itself or comments/grades.

The only student information they see is their child's first name.



Before you begin

You can get email summaries sent to any email address. However, to view or update email summary settings, you need a Google Account. With a Google Account, you can change the frequency of your emails, update your time zone, see the students connected to your account, and unsubscribe from email summaries. For details, go to Create a Google Account.

If you unsubscribe from email summaries, you're still connected to a student as long as you have a Google Account. Otherwise, unsubscribing removes you as a guardian.

You can only get summaries if your student is using Classroom with a Google Workspace account, which looks like *student_name@school.edu*. If you're not sure, ask the teacher or school administrator.

Get email summaries

To get email summaries of your student's work, you must accept an email invitation from a teacher or administrator. You have 120 days to accept an invitation before it expires. You can unsubscribe from summaries or remove yourself as a guardian at any time.

- 1. The teacher or administrator emails you an invitation to join your student's class.
- 2. In your email program, open your email invitation.
- Click Accept.
 If you're not the guardian, click I'm Not The Guardian.
- 4. Click Accept to confirm.

When you accept an invitation, you and your student get an email confirmation.

Why do students need to opt-in?

- They must consent to sharing information, similar to how Praising Stars reports are distributed to students rather than directly to guardians
- We obtain consent from the guardian via the student to ensure we can provide their email address to Google for this purpose
- Helps to ensure guardians' email addresses are up to date and accurate

How does a guardian opt-out of receiving the emails?

They can click the link to 'unsubscribe' at the bottom of any emails they receive.

MyOn

MyOn is an online reading platform which allows student to access books within school and at home.

MyOn is always updating offering new books and newspaper articles for student to read on a daily basis. Currently there are over 5,000 books available.

All students at City Fields have access to a MyOn account.






MyOn


Myon is tailored to each individual student recommending books based on their interests and reading age.

MyOn is an interactive platform which can be used in a number of different ways. Students can read the books to themselves, record themselves reading the books or listen to the book.


After finishing a book or articles students will complete a quiz to check their understanding of the book and information.

- Thursdays after school in science, S6 from 2:30-3:30.



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
Subscribe

The question format in Educake


- True/false

Staff can use the Educake to address any misconceptions, target students not doing well and support them, praise students, use questions from Educake during lessons to bridge the learning gap.




Rewards


